To change the Standard AST to No Deposit AST

If no deposit is taken then the tenancy will be outside the Housing Act 2004 requirements for tenancy deposit protection. The following changes provide a simple way of making such a change. IT ASSUMES THE TENANCY IS STILL AN AST. If it is contractual without a deposit apply these changes to the Contractual tenancy (some will already have been made.)

Further editing could be undertaken if desired (such as removing the relevant person and renumbering), but it is not necessary.
